TECH TIP

The 8x8 and 10x10 scale base sub-platters are attached to the loadcells through the use of two 1/4 x 20 phillips flat head screws. If these screws need to be replaced for any reason it is vital that they are replaced with the same type screws. If the same type screws are not used there is the possibility that the top platter will not sit properly on the sub-platter which in turn could cause the scale to not weigh properly.
